- 4. Whether similar or equivalent service is provided to other pupils eligible for transportation
- 5. Whether and to what extent the additional service unavoidably disrupts current transportation schedules
- 6. Whether other reimbursable types of transportation are available; and

WHEREAS the option of offering payment-in-lieu of transportation is provided in Ohio Revised Code: Therefore, be it

RESOLVED that the Southeastern Local School District Board of Education hereby approves the declaration that it is impractical to transport the student(s) identified herein and offers the parent(s)/guardian(s) of students named on the attachment, payment-in-lieu of transportation at the rate of \$225.22 for the remainder of the 2012-2013 school year.
