#### MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Between the Southeastern Local School District Board of Education and the Southeastern Local Education Association

This Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") is hereby agreed to by and between the Southeastern Local School District Board of Education ("Board") and the Southeastern Local Education Association ("Association"), who are parties to a negotiated Master Agreement in effect from July 1, 2014 through June 30, 2017, ("Master Agreement") as follows:

**WHEREAS**, Article 6, Section M of the Parties' Master Agreement provides "[e]ach full-time teacher in grades K-12 shall have at least forty (40) consecutive minutes of planning time within a standard school day when students are present. The equivalent in time will be provided for any teacher less than full-time"; and

**WHEREAS**, due to instructional time needs at the District's pre-school, a bargaining unit member, Angi Kaverman has been granted all planning time on Fridays during the workweek/workday rather than throughout the workweek per workday as provided for in Article 6, Section M of the Master Agreement; and

**WHEREAS**, the Parties mutually desire to memorialize their understanding and agreement regarding the alternate provision of planning time for Angi Kaverman;

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AND AGREED** that the Board will provide Angi Kaverman with 200 minutes of planning time per workweek on Fridays during the workday and such time will not be provided on a per workday basis;

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND AGREED** that by way of this MOU, the parties specifically and voluntarily waive the application of the negotiated language of Article 6, Section M, of the Master Agreement as it otherwise applies to Angi Kaverman;

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND AGREED** that the terms of this Memorandum of Understanding are non-precedent setting, and do not apply to or effect any other provision of the Master Agreement;

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND AGREED** that the terms of this Memorandum of Understanding shall be in effect for the 2016-2017 contract year only, and shall automatically expire without any further action required by either Party, unless otherwise mutually agreed to in writing by the Parties.

**Class of 2017 - No change.** All currently weighted classes, including CC+ course taken off campus will be calculated on weighted GPA scale. Highest overall weighted GPA, at the end of the 3rd quarter of the senior year, will be recognized as valedictorian and second highest GPA as salutatorian. (GPAs will be hand calculated reflecting 2015-2016 weighted scale)

**Class of 2018** - To be considered for valedictorian and salutatorian students must have taken (or currently be enrolled in) 7 of the following 12 courses:

\*Graduating "With Distinction" - Unlike the Valedictorian and Salutatorian status the honor of graduating with Academic Distinction indicates a grouping rather that a singular position. Those graduating with Academic Distinction for the 2020 year and beyond have completed and/or are currently enrolled in the some combination of **10** of the above courses and have an unweighted GPA of at least 3.0.
