Mr. Mervin Britton, long time educator for thirty-three years in Clark County, has established a trust through Park National Bank for scholarships benefiting Clark County High School students. Each county high school will have the opportunity to submit applications of qualified candidates to the Clark County Educational Service Center during the spring of each year.

Mr. Britton came to New Carlisle Local, now Tecumseh Local, in 1945 to teach math at New Carlisle High School. After teaching many years, Mr. Britton became a school counselor at Tecumseh High School. In 1961, he came to the Clark County Board of Education, now the Clark County Educational Service Center, as Pupil Personnel and attendance officer. Mr. Britton retired from the ESC in June 1974.

The applicant must be accepted for enrollment in a four-year college or university to receive formal training in teaching or related areas (school psychology, speech and language pathology, occupational therapy, physical therapy)

Park National Bank will send a scholarship check to the student's college or university. The scholarship is renewable for three succeeding years (for a total of \$10,000) if the student remains eligible.

General Information

In 2025 we will award up to 10 \$2,500 renewable scholarships!

Basic Requirements

To qualify for the scholarship, high school students must:

1. Rank in the upper one third of their high school class;
2. High school grade point average of 2.75 or higher;
3. Have an ACT score of 22 or higher or SAT score of 1000 or higher; and
4. Enrolled full time (12 or more credit hours) in an accredited four-year institution of higher learning.

Application Deadline

The application, including recommendations, transcripts, and other attachments must be received by the county office no later than April 25, 2025.
